Eligibility: Open to all boys age 12 to 18 **as of August 26, 2017**. **Note:** Boys age 18 may participate **only if they have not started college prior to August 26, 2017**.

Entry Fee: \$70 per player for JGANC members; \$80 per player for non-JGANC members - includes green fees, range balls, lunch, tee prizes, and awards

There are a limited number of spots for non-JGANC members. **Non-JGANC members must register using the entry form printed below and will be accommodated on a space available basis in the order they are received.**

NO REFUNDS AFTER AUGUST 1, 2017. ENTRIES POSTMARKED PRIOR TO MAY 6, 2017 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. This tournament fills quickly and entries should be submitted at the earliest acceptable date. **Deadline for entry is 11:59 PM, August 20, 2017.** Submission of an entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$25 service fee on all returned checks.

Format: Boys ages 12-13 will play 18 holes of medal play from the Navigator (silver) tees (5,271 yards). Boys age 14-18 will play 18 holes of medal play from the Bomber (black) tees (6,767 yards). The 12-13 boys will tee off first beginning at 8:00 AM followed by the 14-15 boys and then the 16-18 boys. A tie in the 12-13 boys division will be played off. A tie for the overall boy's champion (from among the 14-15 and 16-18 divisions) will be played off. All other ties will be broken in accordance to USGA Rule 33-6.

Awards: **Boys 12-13** – First, second and third place awards will be presented.

Boys 14-18 - First, second and third place awards will be presented in the boys 14-15 age division. First, second and third place awards will be presented in the boys 16-18 division. The overall boy's champion will come from the 14-15 or 16-18 boys divisions and will be crowned the 2017 State Fair Boys Champion. He will receive the overall champion's award and his name will be inscribed on a perpetual trophy.

Presentation of awards will take place following the conclusion of the tournament. Per JGANC rules, All winners are must be present to accept their awards. Final results will be posted on the JGANC and SGC website.

Rules: All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. All players must abide by the JGANC rules. **CADDIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Spectators must stay at least 25 yards away from players at all times AND MUST STAY ON CART PATHS. Players are not permitted to converse with parents or spectators during play. Misconduct will result in player disqualification. Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard (rule 6-6b). Players are responsible for being on the tee when called, or an appropriate penalty will be assessed. The use of cellular phones, pagers, cameras or any similar equipment on the golf course during competition is prohibited. Range finders that measure distance only will be permitted.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT – The use of abusive language, throwing of golf clubs, or other disruptive behavior will not be allowed – PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION

Recommended dress code: appropriate golf attire - denim clothing is discouraged. Mather is a "soft spike" facility. Metal, penetrating golf shoe spikes are prohibited.

Check in: **Check in at Mather at least 30 minutes before your starting time. Tee times and pairings will be sent via email three (3) days prior to the event and announced on the Sacramento Golf Council website at:**
