



6th Annual Sacramento City Men's Net Amateur Championship Saturday & Sunday, June 5 & 6, 2010

BING MALONEY GOLF COURSE

Eligibility: This tournament is open to all male amateur golfers age 18 or older with a handicap index not to exceed 20.0 as calculated in accordance with the USGA GHIN System. **Handicap indexes will be verified by the Tournament Committee for June 1, 2010. The SGC reserves the right to adjust a contestant's handicap based on tournament scores.**

Entry Fees/Registration:

\$115.00 per person - Includes (2) days green fee and awards (power carts not included). Field is limited to the first 120 paid entries. Submission of an entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee.

Please visit www.sacgolfcouncil.org if you would like to register and pay online; or you can mail this completed entry form with a check made payable to the "Sacramento Golf Council" for \$115. The **deadline to register by mail is 5pm on May 28, 2010** and the **deadline to register online is 11pm on May 28, 2010**. No refunds after May 28th (call Tournament Director Dewey Sutton at (916)987-1449 for cancellations). There will be a \$20.00 service charge on all returned checks; \$10 fee assessed for ANY cancellations.

Format: Play will be 36 holes of stroke play at full handicap over a two-day period. Contestants will be assigned to flights according to handicaps and the number of entries received.

Awards: The player with the lowest 36-hole net score will be declared the Sacramento City Net Amateur Champion. His name will be inscribed on the perpetual trophy. **He will also be afforded free entry into the State Fair Net Championship in September.** Gift certificates will be awarded based on net scores in each flight. Ties for the championship will be resolved by sudden death playoff. All other ties will be resolved by matching scorecards in accordance with the USGA recommended method. Presentation of awards will take place immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. All winners are requested to be present to accept their awards.

Rules: All play will be governed by the current USGA Rules of Golf, its Decisions, and the conditions listed on the Notice to Competitors distributed prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, the competitors shall use Rule 3-3 (play an alternate ball) and refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. Players are responsible for reporting to the first tee 10 minutes before their tee time, or an appropriate penalty (Rule 6-3) will be assessed. Players are responsible for returning their own signed, attested and completed scorecard to the scoring table as quickly as possible.

Recommended dress code: Appropriate golf attire— shirts with sleeves, no tank tops - jeans are discouraged.

Starting Times/

Check-in: Contestants should check in at the check-in table at at least 20 minutes prior to their tee time. Starting times and pairings will be posted on the SGC website at www.sacgolfcouncil.org, or will be available by calling the Pro-Shop at (916) 433-2283 (TTY 391-8000), three days prior to the event.
