Eligibility: Open to all boys and girls ages 7 to 18 **as of August 28, 2021. Note:** Girls and Boys age 18 may participate **only if they have not started college prior to August 28, 2021.**

Entry Fee: Ages 7-11 - \$30 per player; Ages 12-18 - \$58 per player – both entry fees include green fees, range balls, and awards

There are a limited number of spots for non-JGANC members. **Non-JGANC members must register using the entry form printed below and will be accommodated on a space available basis in the order they are received.**

NO REFUNDS AFTER AUGUST 15, 2021. ENTRIES POSTMARKED PRIOR TO April 1, 2021 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. This tournament fills quickly, and entries should be submitted at the earliest acceptable date. **Deadline for entry is 11:59 PM, August 15, 2021.** Submission of an entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$25 service fee on all returned checks.

Format: **Girls and Boys Ages 7-11** will play 9 holes of medal play with tee times starting at 8:00AM on the Arcade Creek Course. There will be two divisions, 7-9 and 10-11. Ties will be broken using the USGA method of matching scorecards. **Boys Ages 12-13** will play 18 holes of medal play from the 3 Oaks tees on the Alister MacKenzie course. **Girls Ages 12-13** will play 18 holes of medal play from the 1 Oaks tees on the Alister MacKenzie course. **Girls Ages 14-18** will play 18 holes of medal play from the 2 Oaks tees on the Alister MacKenzie course. **Boys Ages 14-18** will play 18 holes of medal play from the 4 Oaks tees on the Alister MacKenzie course. All play for the **12-18 Girls and Boys** will commence on the first tee with starting times beginning at 8:00AM. Boys ages 12-13 will tee off first, followed by girls ages 12-13, girls ages 14-15, girls ages 16-18, boys ages 14-15 and boys ages 16-18. If COVID-19 protocols permit, ties for the overall boys champion (from the 14-15 and 16-18 age groups) and overall girls champion (from the 14-15 and 16-18 age groups) will be played off. All other ties will be broken using the USGA method of matching scorecards.

Awards: Overall Boys and Girls champions will have their names placed on perpetual trophies. Awards will be presented to the first, second and third place low gross scorers in each age group. If COVID-19 protocols permit, presentation of awards will take place following the conclusion of the tournament for each age group. Per JGANC rules, **all winners must be present to accept their awards.** Final results will be posted on the JGANC and SGC websites.

Rules: All play will follow United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. All players must abide by the JGANC rules. **CADDIES ARE NOT ALLOWED** for the 12-18 age groups but may be provided for the 7-11 age groups. Spectators must stay at least 25 yards away from players at all times AND MUST STAY ON CART PATHS. Players are not permitted to converse with parents or spectators during play except for parents caddying for their 7-11 year old son or daughter. Misconduct will result in player disqualification. Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard (rule 6-6b). Players are responsible for being on the tee when called, or an appropriate penalty will be assessed. The use of cellular phones, pagers, cameras or any similar equipment on the golf course during competition is prohibited. **Range finders that measure distance only will be permitted.**

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT – The use of abusive language, throwing of golf clubs, or other disruptive behavior will not be allowed – PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION

Recommended dress code: appropriate golf attire - denim clothing is discouraged. Haggin Oaks is a “soft spike” facility. Metal, penetrating golf shoe spikes are prohibited.

Check in: **Check in with the first tee starter at least 10 minutes before your starting time. Tee times and pairings will be sent via email three (3) days prior to the event and announced on the Sacramento Golf Council website at:**
