



# 2023 Peggy Dodds Memorial 87<sup>th</sup> Sacramento City Jr Championship

July 5-6, 2023 – Wednesday & Thursday

**Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all junior golfers ages 7-18 as of July 5, 2023. **Golfers aged 18 may participate as long as they have not started college prior to July 5, 2022.**

**Entry Fees:** Non-JGANC members \$130 for ages 12-18; \$85 for ages 7-11. Ages 7-11 who are non-JGANC members will be accommodated prior to the entry deadline. **However, per JGANC's policy, non-JGANC players who are ages 12-18 will be accommodated only if space is available after the entry deadline for JGANC members.** You must contact Steve Yates, Tournament Director, at 916-508-8985 or [steve@steveyates.com](mailto:steve@steveyates.com) to let him know that you will be registering as a non-JGANC member. Use the entry form at the bottom of the page.

All entry fees include green fees, range balls, awards and a box lunch on Thursday, July 6<sup>th</sup> only. Field is limited to 120 paid entries. **Deadline for entry is 11:59 p.m. June 21, 2023.**

**Format:** Ages 12 to 18 will play 36 holes medal play on the Alister MacKenzie course, with tee times starting at 9:00 AM on July 5 and tee times starting at 7:00 AM on July 6. Ages 7-11 will play 9 holes medal play on the Arcade Creek course with tee times starting at 9:00 AM on July 5 and tee times starting at 7:00 AM on July 6. Players will be paired as closely as possible by age and ability. Second day pairings will be determined by scores posted on the first day.

**Awards:** The overall boys champion (from the 14-15 and 16-18 age groups) and the overall girls champion (from the 14-15 and 16-18 age groups) will have their names placed on the perpetual trophies. In the event of a tie for either of the overall champions, there will be a sudden death playoff. All other ties will be broken by matching scorecards. Awards will be presented to the low gross scorers in each age group. Presentation of awards will take place following the conclusion of the tournament at the scoreboard area. **All winners must be present to accept their awards as required by JGANC.**

**Rules:** All play will follow United State Golf Association (USGA) rules, except for local rules posted by the Tournament Committee prior to play. In the absence of a rules official, players shall refer any disputes to the Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final. All players must abide by the JGANC rules. Spectators must be always at least 25 yards from players. **CADDIES ARE ALLOWED FOR AGES 7-11 only.** Players are not permitted to converse with parents or spectators during play. Misconduct will result in disqualification. Players are responsible for returning their own attested and correct scorecard. Players are responsible for being on the tee on time. Cell phones, pagers or cameras are prohibited during competition. Range finders will be allowed for distance only.

**UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT** – The use of abusive language, throwing of golf clubs, or other disruptive behavior will not be allowed – **PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION**

**Recommended dress code:** appropriate golf attire – shirts with sleeves, no tank tops – shorts should be hemmed just above the knees, or slacks – denim clothing is discouraged. Haggin Oaks is a spikeless facility. Metal, penetrating golf shoes are prohibited.

**Times:** All rounds start when scheduled. Players must check in with the starter on the first tee at least 10 minutes prior to their scheduled start time. Start times and pairings will be posted on the SGC website [www.sacgolfcouncil.org](http://www.sacgolfcouncil.org) and at Haggin Oaks prior to the tournament.
